



Resolution dated 13 March 2020 from the interim Chancellor of the University of Zaragoza on the suspension of on-site academic activities at the University of Zaragoza under the Action protocol at this university in response to the health alert caused by COVID-19.

In accordance with the Action protocol in place at the University of Zaragoza in response to the health alert caused by COVID-19, considering its spread and in line with instructions from the authorities in the Autonomous Region of Aragon, having consulted the Committee on this Protocol, the Chancellor resolves:

First: To suspend all academic activities at the University of Zaragoza from this coming Monday 16 March 2020 until Sunday 29 March 2020, inclusive.

Second: This measure will likewise entail the suspension of activities or closure of the following facilities and services:

- Classrooms and laboratories where classes are given, including field trips and activities related to doctoral studies.
- Libraries (except the inter-library lending service and online/telephone consultation services) and Study Rooms.
- Sports facilities.
- Jaca Hall of Residence.
- University of Zaragoza Veterinary Hospital.
- Students' Residence.
- On-site engagements related to collaboration grants, UNIZAR maintenance grants and curricular/extracurricular practical activities.
- Cafeterias, bars and restaurants in UNIZAR facilities. This measure does not affect those at the 'Colegios Mayores'.
- Printing and photocopying services located in UNIZAR facilities.
- Congresses, Courses, Seminars and similar sessions scheduled in UNIZAR facilities.
- Activities agreed on by covenant which should take place in UNIZAR facilities and permits for temporary use or lease of UNIZAR facilities.
- The Easter holiday exchange programme.

Third: Apart from staff pertaining to the units which are closed to the public, both TRS (Teaching and Research Staff) -apart from teaching duties- and ASS (Administration and Services Staff) shall continue to work, offering their services as normal.

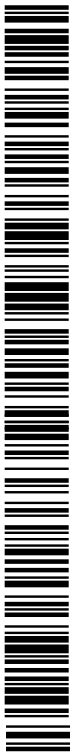
In order to protect and manage health in the workplace and balance work and family obligations among the staff, flexitime and remote working are being instituted. This has been arranged in concert with the legal representatives of the staff.

Fourth: The TRS will provide added support and tutoring for students through the 'ADD' ('Anillo Digital Docente') UNIZAR and by email. No face-to-face meetings or tutorials will be arranged with students.

Fifth: Once the suspension period is over, the university will reschedule the academic activities that have been affected (to the extent this proves possible). In any case, students' right to assessment is guaranteed.

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Sixth: Wherever possible, all postponed external activities will be rescheduled.

Seventh: The centres are responsible for informing of the suspension of scheduled activities in university facilities to the persons or entities that were intending to run them, and for reporting to the Bureau of the Chancellor by email to: jefegabi@unizar.es

Eighth: Dealerships will be informed of the suspension by the Economics and Finance Department through the Assets, Purchasing and Procurement Service.

Ninth: Force majeure necessitates the adoption of corrective measures in terms of an expansion or reduction in the work undertaken by the companies who provide the cleaning and safety services to adapt their work to this period of temporary suspension.

Tenth: This resolution to suspend academic activities will be published on the Transparency Portal and on the university's website. Similarly, this resolution will be conveyed to:

- The relevant health authorities.
- The Directorate General for Universities at the Government of Aragon.
- Management and Administration bodies at the centres and 'IUJ' and those in charge of UNIZAR services.
- The UNIZAR Students' Council.
- The centres and institutes affiliated to UNIZAR.
- The universities with a national or international student mobility agreement with UNIZAR.
- The UNIZAR Staff Board and members of MNUZ.
- The Business or Inter-Enterprise Committee.

Eleventh: Basic measures shall always entail following the recommendation from the Health Authority on COVID-19. On the same lines, a Q&A guide will be posted on our website for the university community to respond to concerns among the student body, TRS and ASS.

Twelfth: A guide filled with Q&As will be made available to the university community at <https://internacional.unizar.es/comunicado-sobre-el-coronavirus-covid-19> to cover any concerns related to the measures adopted in this resolution that may arise among the student body, TRS and ASS.

Thirteenth: This Resolution modifies the first section of the Resolution dated 12 March 2020 **solely in the matter of essential activities for the pursuit of academic activities**. Further modifications may be made depending on the evolution of the health alert and instructions from the relevant authorities.
