

FIGHTING PREJUDICE : INTERCOMPREHENSION AND INTERCULTURALITY

General information

Objectives and Description: This BIP aims to use the intercultural communication skills developed to build collaborative projects in an intercultural context. To facilitate exchanges, students will be trained in intercomprehension and will take part in workshops given by academics and representatives of the Préjugix Association, which prepares students in a playful and collaborative way for the prevention of prejudice. Other collaborative and cultural activities are also planned, such as a visit to Pau and street art.
